Managed Medications

If you require temperature-controlled medications, please complete the following form and bring it with you (along with your medications) the morning the ride begins on Thursday, May 16th. The medication list and medications will be reviewed and then secured in a locked container.

- Medications will be available to you at breakfast, lunch and dinner.
- Any medications taken "as needed" will *not* be accepted for storage.
- If you take a medication at bedtime, the medication will be given to you at dinner (in a marked plastic bag) for use at bedtime.
- Any diabetic blood sugar testing supplies (test strips, meter) may also be held in storage. However, if you may need to test your blood sugar while riding, you should keep enough of these materials with you to test during the ride.

At the end of the event, medications will be available for pick-up during closing ceremonies. Medications may also be picked up during breakfast of the last day of the ride (Sunday, May 19th).
